The KSE-100 Index fluctuated within a narrow band, recording an intraday low of 118,665 and a high of 119,543, before settling at 119,103, down 50 points. Total market volume reached 99.4 million shares, with a traded value of PKR 10.5 billion.</li> <li>The index faced downward pressure primarily due to declines in major stocks including FFC (-0.5%, -55 points), MCB (-1.1%, -42 points), SYS (-1%, -35 points), MARI (-0.6%, -32 points), and PPL (-0.8%, -29 points).
